
Our Commitment to Diversity

Originally called "Anna's Book Angel Project" in memory of Anna K. Bonde, this program has provided over 90,000 free braille books to children since 2002!

Each child with vision loss ages 0-21 in the U.S. and Canada can now receive 5 free braille books from Seedlings per calendar year.

You must re-register the child each calendar year.

Teachers of the Visually Impaired Program (TVIP)

So TVIs can have some free books, too!

TVIP allows certified teachers of visually impaired students in the U.S. to order 5 free braille books from Seedlings per calendar year!

Since 2019, this program has sent over 21,000 books to teachers across the U.S.

You must re-register each calendar year.

Braille for Beginners (B4B)

Placing our books into the hands of toddlers and preschoolers ages 0-3 with vision loss became a priority when we realized that success in school and beyond depends heavily on children and their families having braille books at an early age. Through the B4B program, hundreds of Print Braille & Picture Books have been sent to Early Intervention Programs across the U.S. to share with the families they serve.

Production and Ordering Details

Availability: We make every effort to ship orders within five business days (but please be sure to allow enough "in transit" time. See SHIPPING below).

Payment: We accept checks, money orders (U.S. funds, please), VISA, MasterCard, and Discover. PayPal & AmEx are also options when you order online. Purchase orders are accepted from U.S. schools, libraries, and agencies (net 30 days).

Privacy: We value your privacy and do not share our lists with anyone.

Production Notes: We use computers to help transcribe our books into braille and embossers to print them. Our books (except the Print Braille & Picture Books) are then bound using plastic combs and covers.

Reading/Interest Levels: Approximate age ranges have been listed for each book, but older children (and even adults) will enjoy these stories too!

Returns: Returns must be in resaleable condition and made within 30 days of the receipt of your order. Please call before returning items. Seedlings is a small nonprofit. If we have made an error, we will fix it right away, but it is difficult for us to bear the costs involved in other returns.

Shipping via USPS "Free Matter for the Blind": Our braille materials are usually shipped "Free Matter for the Blind" for no charge. "Free Matter" often takes 1 to 3 weeks in the U.S. and about 4 to 8 weeks to foreign destinations, and it cannot be traced. All packages to Alaska, Hawaii, and foreign countries must be shipped "Free Matter" (no UPS).

Shipping via UPS: People in the Continental U.S. may select UPS Ground for a charge of 15% (\$11 minimum). If you require special services like UPS 3-Day, 2-Day, Overnight, or Signed Proof of Delivery, we will need to add the extra charge to your invoice.

About Our Braille Books

The Current Braille Code Unified English Braille (UEB)

In November 2012, the Braille Authority of North America (BANA) voted to adopt the Unified English Braille Code (UEB) as the official code for the United States. We then joined several other countries who adopted UEB before us. The new code was implemented in the U.S. on January 4, 2016 and since then, we have converted over 800 of our books to UEB, making Seedlings a leader in UEB books for children.

We started with our books for younger children (please see Page 1) and have worked our way up to our popular big books for older children and teens. Some of the bigger books are still be available in the old code (EBAE), and they are listed on our website (seedlings.org).

Uncontracted vs Contracted Braille

Uncontracted Braille is the simplest form of braille. It consists of a symbol for each letter of the alphabet and a few for punctuation. In Contracted Braille, several dozen special symbols (contractions and short forms) were added to make the books shorter and faster to read.
